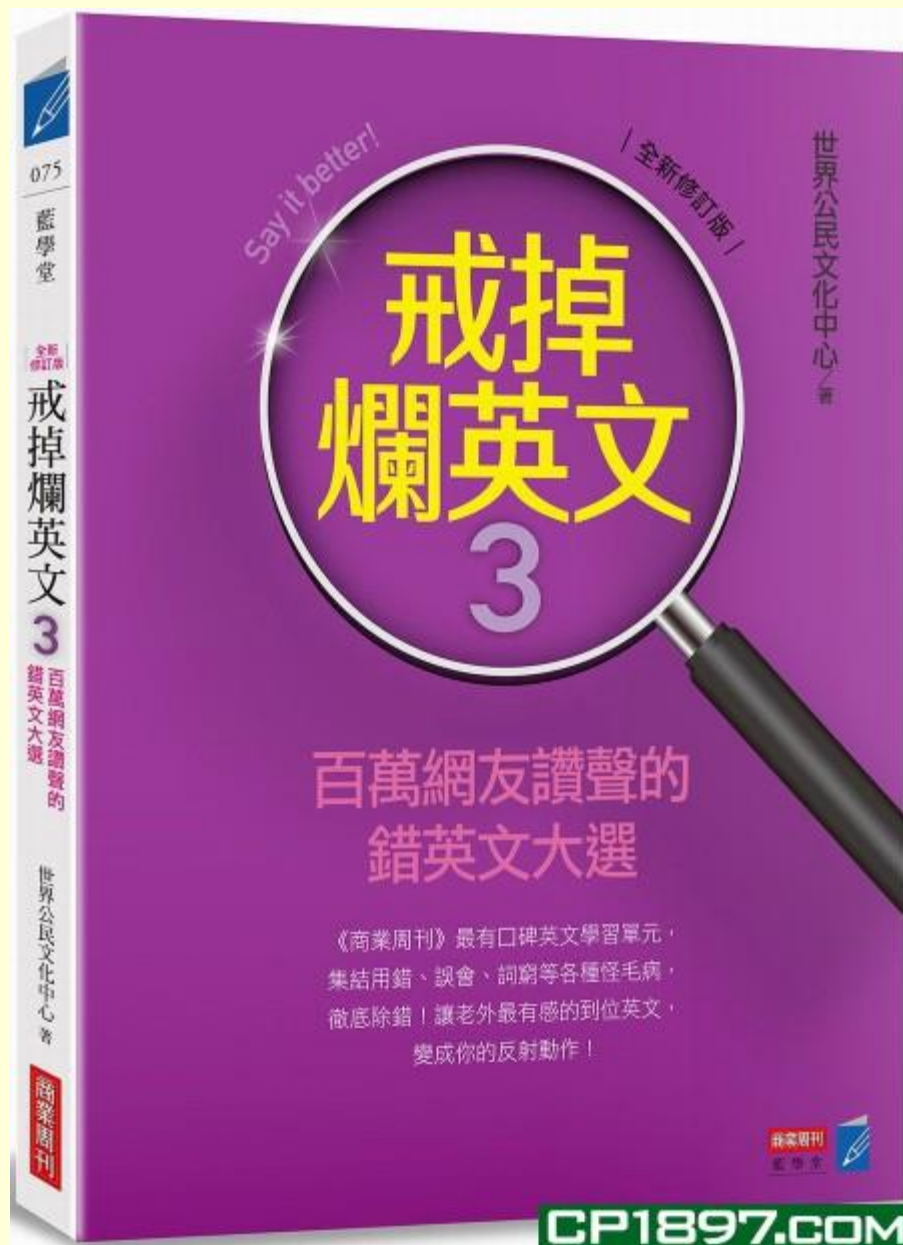


# 好書推介

4. 如果有人問你，“What’s your job?”，假若你是一個老師，你應該怎樣回應呢？

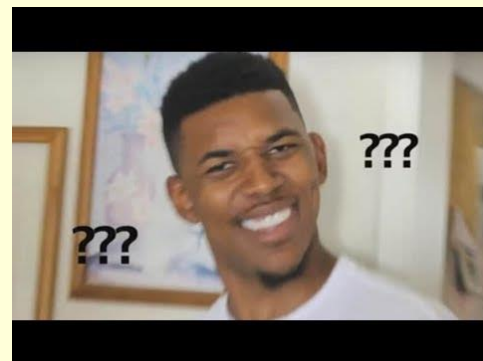
a. My job is a teacher.
